What is the Program?

Illinois Solar for All (ILSFA) program increases accessibility to solar energy for low-income households, non-profit organizations, and public facilities by providing incentives to help make solar more affordable. The ILSFA Low-Income Distributed Generation sub-program (ILSFA-LIDG), one of three within ILSFA, provides incentives for solar installations which are located at residential properties occupied by low-income households.

The eligibility criteria for multi-family residential properties to qualify for the ILSFA-LIDG program require that at least half of the units on your property are occupied by households with incomes of 80% or less of the area median income.
