Illinois Solar For All Program Provides Incentive to Go Solar and Lower Energy Costs

☉ What is the Program?

Illinois Solar for All (ILSFA) program increases accessibility to solar energy for low-income households, non-profit organizations, and public facilities by providing incentives to help make solar more affordable. The ILSFA Low-Income Distributed Generation sub-program (ILSFA-LIDG), one of three within ILSFA, provides incentives for solar installations which are located at residential properties occupied by low-income households.

As an Approved Vendor Designee in the Illinois Solar for All program, StraightUp Solar can assist you in accessing this program to fund your solar photovoltaic (PV) system.

Our initial analysis indicates that installing a solar PV system on your property can reduce your energy bill. The eligibility criteria for multi-family residential properties to qualify for the ILSFA-LIDG program require that at least half of the units on your property are occupied by households with incomes of 80% or less of the area median income.
